Work must be previously unpublished to be considered for publication in cutting teeth

Please state your name, address and e-mail clearly on each submission.

Both prose and poetry submissions are invited in the following format:
Typed or printed on white A4, using one side of page only
Single line space
Font: aerial or Helvetica. Size: 12 points
Format Microsoft word or .rtf
Hand written submissions are not acceptable

Stories

Do not send more than 3 stories
No longer than 2500 words in length
Word count to be stated along side title

Poetry

Do not send more than 6 poems
Each poem on a separate page

We will accept submission by post only

Make sure appropriate postage is paid
Work cannot be returned if a SAE has not been sent (again with appropriate postage). If you would like to receive acknowledgment of receipt of your work please enclose an additional stamped SAE.
